### **Title : BD & OP Forms**

Anchor	<p>Starting from October 2023, Hong Kong Housing Authority will implement new measures and arrangements to combat tenancy abuses under the enhanced “Well-off Tenants Policies”.</p> <p>After admission to Public Rental Housing, tenants and all household members are required to declare occupancy status and domestic property ownership in Hong Kong.</p>
Super	<p>Enhance efforts to combat tenancy abuse</p> <p>To declare occupancy status and domestic property ownership in Hong Kong every two years</p>
Anchor	<p>To safeguard the rational use of public housing resources</p> <p>Prevent any abuse</p>
Super	<p>Safeguard the rational use of public housing resources</p> <p>Prevent any abuse</p>
Super	<p>Classification of Forms</p>
Anchor	<p>The declaration forms will be distributed in batches</p>
Super	<p>Declaration forms will be distributed in batches</p>
Anchor	<p>In the first batch, declaration forms will be delivered to households who have resided in public housing for two to eight years.</p> <p>However, for the sake of simplifying administration, the first batch will not include all elderly households. Declaration forms will be distributed to all elderly households in subsequent batches.</p>
Super	<p>Declaration forms will be distributed to the mailboxes of households on 3 October</p> <p>All elderly households are not included in the first batch</p>

Anchor	Households who have been living in public housing for more than two years and have not yet been required to declare income, assets and domestic property ownership under the “Well-off Tenants Policies” are required to fill in the “Declaration Form on Occupancy Status and Particulars of Domestic Property Ownership in Hong Kong”.
Super	“Declaration Form on Occupancy Status and Particulars of Domestic Property Ownership in Hong Kong”
Anchor	All household members are required to declare the occupancy status and whether they own domestic property in Hong Kong.
Super	All household members must declare
Anchor	For households who are required to declare income, assets and domestic property ownership under the “Well-off Tenants Policies”, they are required to fill in this “Declaration Form on Occupancy Status” only.

Anchor	Before making declarations,
Super	Notes for Declaration “Declaration Form on Occupancy Status and Particulars of Domestic Property Ownership in Hong Kong”
Anchor	Please read the Notes for Declaration carefully
Anchor	Before signing the two declaration forms above, please read the notes and declarations in the declaration forms carefully.
Super	Read the notes and declarations in the declaration forms carefully.

Anchor	Tenants and all family members aged 18 or above must sign the declaration form to confirm the accuracy of the declared information. Family members aged below 18 are not required to sign.
Super	The signature of the tenant must be the same as that on the Tenancy Agreement.
Anchor	All the particulars furnished in the declaration form must be true and correct.
Super	Declare information honestly
Anchor	Do not make false statements. Any person who knowingly makes any false statement shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction, to a fine or imprisonment.
Super	Making a false statement shall be guilty of an offence.
Anchor	Households who refuse to make declarations or fail to make declarations within the specified time will have their tenancies terminated. Households who have received the declaration form should remember to submit to the Housing Department timely
