Construction and Temporary Traffic Arrangement for Footbridge connecting Hoi Ying Estate and Hoi Tat Estate, Sham Shui Po

The Hong Kong Housing Authority is constructing a footbridge spanning across the West Kowloon Highway and Lin Cheung Road to connect Hoi Ying Estate and the future Hoi Tat Estate, Sham Shui Po to enhance the connectivity of the retail, community and transport facilities in these new public housing developments.

According to current progress, the Contractor will tentatively erect the footbridge on 29 December 2019 (Sunday) morning. During the works, the West Kowloon Highway and Lin Cheung Road within Sham Shui Po and Yau Tsim Mong areas will be closed in stages from the evening of 28 December 2019 (Saturday), followed by full lane closures of the highways from 12:30am to 5:30am, 29 December 2019 (Sunday). Should there be any unforeseen circumstances, the road closure may need to be slightly extended. After the footbridge erection, the Contractor will continue with the installations of balustrade, building services and finishing works etc. on the bridge deck, with a view to complete the footbridge by end 2020 for opening to the residents.
