To enhance security of public housing estates
the Housing Department has installed
at the entrances of most buildings
password-activated security gates
If residents use these gates properly
strangers can't get into the buildings easily
To ensure that the gates work properly
we must know how to use them
The 'push' and 'pull' signs must be followed
Don't push when it says 'pull' and vice versa
Opening the gate by force will upset its normal operations
Don't push or pull too hard
and open the gate wider than 90 degrees
This will damage the hinges
If you're carrying heavy loads
or in need of assistance
please ask the security guard to help you open the gate
If you find the gate being damaged on purpose
Please report it to the estate office at once
Use the gate properly for your own safety
