

Super	Basic Principles
Anchor	<p>If households' family income exceeds 5 times the public rental housing income limits</p> <p>or the total net household assets exceed 100 times the public rental housing income limits</p> <p>or have domestic property ownership in Hong Kong</p> <p>or refuse to declare</p> <p>the households will be required to vacate their public rental housing flats</p>
Super	Households that are required to vacate their PRH flats but have a temporary housing need may apply for a fixed-term licence to stay in their flats
Anchor	<p>If households have a temporary housing need</p> <p>they may apply for a fixed-term licence to stay in PRH for a period of not more than 12 months during which a licence fee equivalent to the double net rent plus rates or market rent will be charged</p> <p>For households who have purchased subsidised sale flats using green form status</p> <p>the existing practice will continue to be in place</p> <p>Such households are not required to surrender their public rental housing flats until they take over the property purchased and can continue to pay the prevailing level of rent</p>
