Title: Maintain drainage pipes properly to prevent the spread of diseases

Super: Maintain drainage pipes properly to prevent the spread of diseases

VO: To prevent the spread of diseases
it is crucial to maintain the drainage pipes in your flat properly
First, don't alter the drainage pipes without approval

Super: Don't alter the drainage pipes without approval
e.g. disconnect the vent pipe

VO: because this will damage the "trap" function of drainage pipes
If you are found to have altered drainage pipes without approval
the Housing Department will require you to employ a qualified technician

Super: Drainage pipes that are altered without approval must be reinstated

VO: to reinstate the drainage pipes to their original condition immediately
so as to ensure good public hygiene and health in public housing estates
To prevent the damage of pipes

Super: Don't place objects on drainage pipes

VO: please don't place objects on them
Using plastic tape or objects to seal the floor drains

Super: Don't use plastic tape or objects to seal the floor drains

VO: Cannot function as a “trap”
To prevent the spread of diseases through the drainage system
we must cultivate this good habit

Super: Pour half a litre of water every week

VO: Pour half a litre of water into the drain outlets
in your bathroom and kitchen every week to ensure the U-traps

Super: Ensure the U-traps contain enough water

VO: contain enough water to prevent viruses or bacteria
from entering your flat through the drainage system

Super: Maintain the drainage pipes properly by pouring water into floor drains regularly

VO: Remember to maintain the drainage pipes properly by pouring water into floor drains
regularly
