### Dr CHENG Hon-kwan, GBS, JP (Chairman)

Dr CHENG Hon-kwan has a long and distinguished public service record, particularly in the fields of education, land, building and transport. He is a former Member of the Executive and Legislative Councils. He is an Honorary Fellow and Past President of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, a Fellow of the Institution of Civil Engineers, a Fellow, Past Vice President and gold Medallist of the Institution of Structural Engineers and an Honorary Member of the Hong Kong Institute of Planners. Dr Cheng was Chairman of Council of the City University and Open University of Hong Kong; Vice Chairman of Council of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology; Chairman of Land and Building Advisory Committee and Applied Research Council. He has been awarded Honorary Doctorates and Fellowships by six UK and Hong Kong universities. Currently he is also the Chairman of the Transport Advisory Committee.

Dr Cheng has been in the profession of structural engineering for many decades and is highly respected in construction and related professional circles.

### Mr John Anthony MILLER, JP (Vice-chairman)

Mr John Anthony MILLER is a graduate of the School of Oriental and African Studies, London and the John F Kennedy School of Government, Harvard. He joined the Hong Kong Government in 1972 serving as an Administrative Officer. He served as Private Secretary to the then Governor, Sir Murray MacLehose, from 1979 to 1982. He was appointed Deputy Director of Trade in November 1986. In 1989, he became

Information Coordinator in the Chief Secretary's Office. He was appointed Director of Marine in October 1991, Director-General of Trade in March 1993 and Director of Housing and Chief Executive of the Housing Authority in July 1996.

### Mr Eddy FONG Ching, SBS, JP

Mr Eddy FONG Ching is a certified public accountant and a partner of the international accounting firm, PricewaterhouseCoopers in Hong Kong. He qualified as a chartered accountant in 1972 and received an Honorary Doctorate in Civil Law from the University of Kent in 1997. Involved in the Authority's activities since 1992, he serves as Chairman of its Finance Committee. His other local public services include serving as Director of the Applied Research Council and as a member of the Federation of Hong Kong Industries and Non-executive Director of the Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation, the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority and the Exchange Fund Investment Limited.

### Mr Raymond CHOW Wai-kam, JP

Mr Raymond CHOW Wai-kam is an architect by profession. He is a member of the Hong Kong Institute of Architects, Royal Institute of British Architects, Royal Australian Institute of Architects and the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. He is the Group Managing Director of Hutchison Whampoa Properties Limited.

He has extensive experience in housing development, design and implementation. He has also served in various community service organizations over the years. He is a member of the Fight Crime Committee, the Hospital Governing Committee of Ruttonjee Hospital,

the Hon Secretary of Executive Committee of the Society for the Aid and Rehabilitation of Drug Abusers and an Adjudicator of the Immigration Tribunal.

### Ms SIU Yuen-sheung, BBS, JP

She is also Chairman of Kowloon City District Women Association. **Mr WAN Man-ye, JP**

Mr WAN Man-ye is a registered professional surveyor. Before establishing his property consultancy firm, M.Y. Wan and Associates Limited in January 1997, he had worked in the Hong Kong Government for ten years in land administration and as a property manager for 17 years in a public listed property group. He was first appointed as a member of the Building Committee of the Housing Authority in April 1994 and became a member of the Housing Authority on 1 April 1996. He is also a member of the Hong Kong Housing Society, member of the Municipal Services Appeals Board, member of the Elderly Commission, Council Member of The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups, and Vice-president of Youth Outreach, a service for runaway youths. Mr Wan is Chairman of the Complaints Committee of the Authority.

**Mr CHAN Bing-woon, SBS, JP**

Mr CHAN Bing-woon is a solicitor and notary public and also a China-appointed Attesting Officer. He is actively involved in community services. He has been a member of the Housing Authority since 1 April 1996 and also serves as the Chairman of the Human Resources Committee and the Task Force on Private Sector Involvement of the Authority. He is the Vice-Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Hong Kong Housing Society, member of the Eastern District Council, member of the Independent Police Complaints Council, member of the Citizens Advisory Committee on Community Relations, ICAC, Council member of the Hong Kong Society of Notaries and also Member of the Advisory Council on Food and Environment Hygiene.

**Dr LAU Kwok-yu, JP**

Dr LAU Kwok-yu is an Associate Professor of the Department of Public and Social Administration, City University of Hong Kong. He was first appointed to the Housing Authority Ad Hoc Committee on Private Domestic Property Ownership by Public Rental Housing Tenants in 1994. He was subsequently appointed to serve the Home Ownership Committee since 1995 and became a full Housing Authority member in 1996. He also joined the Authority's Complaints Committee between 1999 and 2001. He was appointed to serve on the Ad Hoc Committee to Review Domestic Rent Policy in March 2001. Dr Lau was a member of the Housing Bureau's Steering Group on Long Term Housing Strategy Review, a member of the Land Development Corporation Appeals Panel and a member of the Housing Affairs Committee of Kwai Tsing District Board. He has been an adviser to the Hong Kong People's Council on Housing Policy since 1984.

He is also a member of the Guangdong Real Estate Research Association Experts Panel, a resource person of the Hong Kong Young Women's Association and a member of the Panel of Experts, Project on Social Development Index for Hong Kong of the Hong Kong Council of Social Service. Dr Lau currently serves on the Review Committee of the Urban Renewal Authority.

**Mr Peter WONG Hong-yuen, GBS, JP**

Mr Peter WONG Hong-yuen is a chartered accountant and senior tax partner of the accountant firm, Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu. He was President of the Hong Kong Society of Accountants from 1984 to 1985 and was an

elected Legislative Councillor to represent the accountancy functional constituency from 1988 to 1995. He is Chairman of the Social Welfare Advisory Committee and the Advisory Council on the Environment. He is also a member of the Court of The University of Hong Kong, the Elderly Commission, the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Advisory Committee and the Commission on Strategic Development. Mr Wong was a member of the Basic Law Consultative Committee, Steering Committee on the British Nationality Scheme and the Securities and Futures Commission. He was President of the Society for the Relief of Disabled Children and Hong Kong Society for the Protection of Children, and is now Chairman of Resource, the Counselling Centre. He is also the President of the Hong Kong Marine Conservation Society and has been the District Grand Master of Hong Kong and the Far East, English Constitution since 1991.

**The Honourable NG Leung-sing, JP**

Mr NG Leung-sing was born in Hong Kong in 1949. His native county is Hesun City in Guangdong Province in PRC. He was awarded the diploma from University of East Asia Graduate College, Macau. Mr Ng is a member of the Legislative Council of the Hong Kong SAR, and is also the Vice-chairman of Chi Yu Banking Corporation Limited.

Mr Ng had been appointed as the Chinese Representative of the Sino-British Land Commission and the trustee of Hong Kong SAR's Government Land Fund from 1988 to 1997. He was the Executive Director, General Manager and the Vice-chairman of the China and South Sea Bank Limited, Hong Kong from 1990 to 2001. Mr Ng is a member of Corporate Contribution Programme Organisation

Committee of the Hong Kong Community Chest since 1992. Moreover, Mr Ng has been appointed as a member of the Hong Kong Housing Authority since 1996. At the same year, he was elected as a member of the Provisional Legislative Council of the Hong Kong SAR. In 1998 and 2000 he was re-elected in the first and second Legislative Council respectively. Mr Ng is a Director of the Charity Fund of the Bank of China Group since 1996. He is a member of Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Advisory Committee since 1998, and as member of Admission of Talents Scheme Selection Committee since 1999. At the same year, Mr Ng is a committee member of Hong Kong Council of Social Service and as a member of The Council and The Court of the Lingnan University. He is appointed as a member of Fisheries Development Loan Fund Advisory Committee and the Justice of the Peace in 2001. He also becomes the committee member of The Hong Kong Chinese Importers' and Exporters' Association in the same year.

**Mr NG Shui-lai, JP**

Mr NG Shui-lai is the Director of Hong Kong Christian Service. He is also the Vice-chairman of the Hong Kong Council of Social Service. During his thirty some years career in the social work profession, he has implemented a number of new services in response to the changing needs in the community. He first introduced the Employee Assistance Programme in Hong Kong that provides professional social work service to the business sector. Mr Ng lectures social work courses in universities and contributes articles on social work and social

She spent seven years with the Hong Kong Government, involved in a wide spectrum of planning tasks before entering private practice in 1990. Her firm has since handled over 400 planning projects in both Hong Kong and Mainland China. Ms Tam was the President of the Hong Kong Institute of Planners (1995-1997) and is also a member of the Planners Registration Board, the Advisory Council on the Environment, and the Chairman of the Appeal Panel under the Estate Agents Ordinance.

Mr WONG Kwun has been involved in the activities of resident organisations since 1978. #### CHUNG Shui-ming, GBS,JP

The Honourable CHUNG Shui-ming graduated from The University of Hong Kong with a BSc degree and an MBA from The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He is a Fellow Member of the Association of Chartered Accountants and the Hong Kong Society of Accountants. Mr Chung is a member of the Executive Council of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, Chairman of the Hong Kong Housing Society, Treasurer of The City University of Hong Kong and a Member of the Long Term Housing Strategy Advisory Committee. He is also a member of the Managing Board of Kowloon-Canton Railway Corporation.

#### Mr Michael CHOI Ngai-min

Mr Michael CHOI Ngai-min was born and educated in Hong Kong. He graduated from the Business Management Department of the Hong Kong Baptist College and later obtained a master degree in business administration from the University of East Asia, Macau. Mr Choi is the Chairman of the Land Power International Holdings Limited and has extensive experience in the real estate industry. He was a member of the All-China Youth Federation (1995-2000), a past president of the Society of Hong Kong Real Estate Agents (1992-1996) and the Founding Chairman of the University of East Asia Graduate College Alumni Association (1988-1990). Mr Ip is the Deputy Chairman of the Democratic Alliance for the Betterment of Hong Kong and the Convenor of the Legislative Council Caucus of the party. #### Professor Patrick LAU Sau-shing, SBS

Professor Patrick LAU Sau-shing is Professor of Architecture, The University of Hong Kong. He was awarded various scholarships to study Architecture in France and Canada and graduated with Thesis Prize at the University of Manitoba, Canada in 1969 and returned to Hong Kong to teach at The University of Hong Kong in 1973 after practicing in Canada. He also received Master of Business Administration in 1988.

Besides teaching, Professor Lau also practises in Hong Kong and completed projects include the University of East Asia in Macau, Pui Ying Secondary School, Jockey Club Tuen Mun Home for the Aged Blind and the Ronald McDonald Home in Shatin. He also received HKIA Annual Awards for the French International School in 1984, the Hong Kong International School in 1989 and the West Island School in 1996. The design of the Hong Kong International School received the American ACSA/AIA School Design Award in 1990; and the design of the Australian International School also received the 2001 Medal of the Year from HKIA.

He was awarded the Pacific Area Tourists Association Heritage & Cultural Award for the design of the Sam Tung Uk Museum in 1987, the Most Accessible Building for the disabled for the design of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Centre for the Blind in 1989. Professor Lau also participated in international competitions and received Honourable Mentions for the Prince George Library and Cultural Centre Competitions in Canada. His design and research have been published widely. He was also awarded the Winning Award for the HKUST Architectural Competition in 1987 and had recently won the competition for the HKIEd Jockey Club Primary School. Professor Lau received the Outstanding Young Persons Award in 1984, the HKIA Outstanding Architect Award in 1991, the Artist of the Year Award in 1999 and the Silver Bauhinia Star in 2000.

Patrick Lau is involved in various community activities. He is now serving as Council Member of St. Paul's College, member of the Architects Registration Board, member of the Housing Authority, member of the Election Committee, HKIA Representative to serve the Appeal Tribunal Panel (Buildings), member of the School Building Design Committee of Education Department, member of the ICAC Operations Review Committee, Board Member of the Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation, Past Chairman of the Outstanding Young Persons Association and current President of the Hong Kong Institute of Architects.

Mr SIN Chung-kai is the legislator representing the Information Technology Functional Constituency. He is well known as an advocate who pioneers IT development in Hong Kong to enable society to benefit from the rapid

development and complete liberalization of the telecommunications market.

Mr Sin has been involved in Hong Kong politics for 15 years and has been an elected representative at all three tiers of the government – Legislative Council (1995-1997) (1998-present), Regional Council (1988-1994) and District Board (now District Council) (1985-present). He also served as the Chairman of Kwai Tsing District Board in 1994-1999.

Mr Sin has served as a member of the Board of Directors of Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation Limited, Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Advisory Committee, Information Infrastructure Advisory Committee, Advisory Committee on Code of Practice for Recognized Certification Authorities and IT Task Force of the Equal Opportunities Commission. He also serves on various other advisory boards both in the public and private sector.

Born and educated in Hong Kong, Mr Sin obtained his MBA from The Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1997 and his BSc from The University of Hong Kong in 1982.

#### Mr Dominic WONG Shing-wah, GBS, JP (Secretary for Housing)

Mr Dominic WONG Shing-wah is the Secretary for Housing of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. He is the Chairman of the Long Term Housing Strategy Advisory Committee, a member of the Land and Building Advisory Committee and a Director of the Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation.
