**Mr. John NG** is an architect as well as town planner. He is a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Architects, and Member of the Royal Institute of British Architects, the Hong Kong Institute of Planners and the Royal Town Planning Institute. He is also an Honorary Associate Professor of the Department of Architecture, University of Hong Kong.

John joined the Hong Kong Housing Authority in 1977 and has extensive experience in the planning, design and construction of high-density public housing in new towns including Shatin, Tuen Mun and Tin Shui Wei, as well as redevelopment projects in Hong Kong Island and urban Kowloon. He was also much involved in the initial development of the Harmony Blocks and Housing for Senior Citizens. A number of awards were won by these projects including the Silver Medal and Merit Awards of the Hong Kong Institute of Architects in 1982, 1987 and 1989, the 2001 Special Award of the Hong Kong Institute of Engineers (Structural Division), and also recently an award in Hong Kong's first Open Architectural Design Competition of Public Housing in the New Era.
