Professor J.M. Ko is the Associate Vice President of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, the Dean of the Faculty of Construction and Land Use and the Chair Professor of Structural Engineering. He is a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, the Institution of Structural Engineers of UK and the American Society of Civil Engineers. He was the President of the Hong Kong Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics in 1999-2000. He is currently a Co-opted Member of the Council, Chairman of the Accreditation Board and the Immediate Past Chairman of the Structural Discipline Advisory Committee of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers. He is the President of The Hong Kong Association for the Advancement of Science and Technology. Since 1997, he has been the Editor-in-Chief of an International Journal – Advances in Structural Engineering. Professor Ko's research interests are in structural dynamics, damage detection and vibration control.
