Michael Moir is the Managing Director, Infrastructure of Pacific Century CyberWorks (PCCW). He is also responsible for the real estate investments in the Pacific Century Group. He started his career in 1972 with Ove Arup & Partners as a civil and structural engineer in Scotland. In 1978 he was posted to Hong Kong to work on the Mass Transit Railway Corporation's Tsuen Wan Depot & Station project. In 1981, he joined Swire Properties Ltd. as a Project Manager. From 1981 to 1989, he managed a number of large-scale property developments, including Taikoo Shing, Beacon Heights, Village Gardens, Parkvale, Lei King Wan and Pacific Place. In 1989 he transferred to the Development & Valuations Department of Swire Properties, becoming its General Manager in 1991 and a Director in 1993. During this period he was responsible for land acquisitions, appraisals, valuations, planning applications, development plans and sales. Major projects included Island Place, Festival Walk, Tung Chung Town Centre, Tung Chung Crescent, TaiKoo Place, 625 King's Road, StarCrest, Les Saisons and Ocean Shores. From 1995 to 1999 he was Chairman of the consortium of five developers undertaking the first development package at Tung Chung Station in partnership with MTRC. In 1999 he left Swire Properties and worked as a property consultant in Hong Kong and UK before joining PCCW in April 2001.

He received his Bachelor of Science (Hons) Degree in Civil Engineering from Aberdeen University in 1972 and his Masters Degree in Civil Engineering from Glasgow University in 1976. He became a Chartered Engineer in 1977 and a Chartered Surveyor in 1987.
