



Safety & Health Alert No. 22/2018 Safety of Working at Bamboo Scaffolds in Proximity to Tramway – Construction Industry Council

HK Tramways reported that two accidents involving bamboo scaffold happened recently, and caused suspension to tram services. A worker working on the scaffold was injured in one of the accidents.
