Animation videos

Seventeen animation videos have already been uploaded to the Labour Department's website to enable the industry to better comprehend how such accidents happened and the necessary preventive measures to prevent their recurrence:

1. Dismantling of Truss-out Bamboo Scaffolds
2. Electrical Work
3. Work at Height Safety
4. Safe Operation of Excavator
5. Fall through a Floor Opening
6. Fall from a Wooden Ladder
7. Struck by Excavator
8. Struck by Falling Objects during Lifting
9. Electrocuted while Clearing Up Electric Arc Welding Equipment
10. Trapped by a Lift Car
11. Struck to Death due to Bursting of Tyre
12. Fall through a Fragile Roof
13. Struck by Falling Object
14. Fall from a Bamboo Scaffold
15. Fall from a Roof Edge
16. Electrical Repairing Work
17. Crushed by Toppled Metal Panels
