Safety & Health Alert No. 13 / 2021 Working at Height, Safety in Lifting Operation and Demolition Works and Tips on Prevention of COVID-19 – OSHC

Last year, Hong Kong had many accidents involving high-risk processes such as working at heights, lifting operation and demolition works.
