



## Safety & Health Alert No. 22 / 2021 Latest Occupational Safety and Health ("OSH") Information from Labour Department

The Labour Department ("LD") is always highly concerned about the fatal and serious accidents involving high-risk processes. LD issues Work Safety Alerts to the relevant industries as soon as possible after each fatal or serious accident to prevent recurrence of similar accidents. To enhance the effectiveness of our publicity and promotion efforts, LD has been producing Work Safety Alerts in the form of animation videos in recent years to enable the industry to better comprehend how such accidents happened and the necessary preventive measures to prevent their recurrence. Up to March of 2021, 19 animation videos of different themes such as work-at-height safety and electrical work safety were produced and uploaded to LD's website and broadcasted through various channels (<u>https://www.labour.gov.hk/eng/news/work\_safety\_alert\_video.htm</u>).
