Hong Kong has a dense traffic network. There are many road maintenance and repair works every day, and excavations of underground utilities. To avoid road works accidents, drivers, workers, and person responsible for road works should implement corresponding safety measures to safeguard road users and ensure a smooth and efficient work progress.
