

Accident Rate per 1000 Workers in last 20 years

Based on information from Labour Department and Housing Authority site returns, the accident rates per 1000 workers of Hong Kong construction industry, Housing Authority New Works and Maintenance Works in last 20 years are as follows:

1. For Hong Kong construction industry, the accident rate is 25.0 in 2024 (projected figures based on Statistics up to the 3rd quarter of 2024), 27.6 in 2023, 29.1 in 2022, 29.5 in 2021, 26.1 in 2020, 29.0 in 2019, 31.7 in 2018, 32.9 in 2017, 34.5 in 2016, 39.1 in 2015, 41.9 in 2014, 40.8 in 2013, 44.3 in 2012, 49.7 in 2011, 52.1 in 2010, 54.6 in 2009, 61.4 in 2008, 60.6 in 2007, 64.3 in 2006, 59.9 in 2005 and 60.3 in 2004.
2. For Housing Authority New Works, the accident rate is 4.2 in 2024 (projected figures based on Statistics up to the 3rd quarter of 2024), 5.2 in 2023, 5.7 in 2022, 5.2 in 2021, 4.5 in 2020, 5.2 in 2019, 7.4 in 2018, 6.9 in 2017, 6.8 in 2016, 9.2 in 2015, 6.4 in 2014, 7.3 in 2013, 7.4 in 2012, 9.0 in 2011, 9.9 in 2010, 9.4 in 2009, 16.1 in 2008, 11.9 in 2007, 11.5 in 2006, 21.0 in 2005 and 29.2 in 2004.
3. For Housing Authority Maintenance Works, the accident rate is 0.3 in 2024 (projected figures based on Statistics up to the 3rd quarter of 2024), 0.7 in 2023, 0 in 2022, 0.7 in 2021, 0.3 in 2020, 5.3 in 2019, 5.7 in 2018, 4.2 in 2017, 1.5 in 2016, 1.5 in 2015, 2.2 in 2014, 4.1 in 2013, 4.8 in 2012, 7.3 in 2011, 7.4 in 2010, 12.3 in 2009, 14.6 in 2008, 9.7 in 2007, 11.3 in 2006, 12.9 in 2005 and 8.8 in 2004.
