Protection against falling objects—important points

- 1. Adequate protection against falling objects, such as nylon meshes and catch-fans, should be provided. Regular inspection of this equipment should be carried out to ensure proper functionality i.e. that they do not contain any gaps, holes or accumulated debris.
- 2. Building contractors are required to incorporate full height temporary protective barriers to all lift shaft openings to avoid personnel and/or objects from falling during construction.
- 3. Covered walkways should be provided to protect workers and pedestrians from falling objects.
- 4. All working platforms and floor edges should be provided with toe-boards to prevent materials from falling from height.
- 5. Workers should be provided with tool straps to help prevent materials and hand tools from falling from height.
- 6. All workers should wear properly fitted safety helmets that conform to international safety standards and are still within their stamped expiry date.
