Woodworking machines— important points

- 1. All dangerous parts of woodworking machines should be safely stored and splitters/riving knives should be provided with circular saw benches.
- An emergency switch or dead man switch should be installed in all woodworking machines.
- 3. Wood chips and dust created should be regularly removed and properly stored/disposed of/recycled.
- 4. Suitable fire extinguishers should be assigned to woodworking machines.
- 5. Woodworking machines should be installed and operated in locations away from any sources of ignition and smoking should be prohibited in their vicinity.
- 6. All employees working with woodworking machinery should be informed of the hazards and take necessary precautions for safe usage.
- 7. All employees working with woodworking machines should be provided with the necessary PPE including hearing protectors which should be used properly.
