Working at height – important points

- 1. Providing safe access to and egress from a workplace, for instance, safe passage, staircase and ladder.
- 2. Providing a safe workplace for every worker, for instance, a proper working platform. If it is not practicable, fall arresting system is needed.
- 3. Appointing competent person with substantial training and experience to conduct regular inspection of scaffolding / working platform, so as to ensure their stability and safety for sustaining the loading of workers and materials.

Definition

Competent person: a person with substantial training and practical experience appointed by the contractor to perform the duty. Substantial training: a formal training in scaffolding works such as the 3-year apprenticeship scheme of Vocational Training Council or 1year full-time basic craft course on scaffolding works of the Hong Kong Institute of Construction.

Competent person with practical experience: working experience of 10 years or more in scaffolding works.

- 4. Conducting regular inspection of scaffolding, working platform and anchorage installations with record of findings. Formulating procedures for dealing with issues identified in inspections.
- Properly designing all special scaffolding / temporary working platform for endorsement by professional engineers. Indicating the safe working load on the scaffolding / temporary working platform.
- 6. Installing proper railing and toe-boards for the periphery of floor slabs, staircases, working platforms and accesses.
- 7. Providing all floor openings with railings and toe-boards, or covering the openings with boards.
- 8. Covering the lift shaft wall openings with full gate lockable gates to prevent fall of persons or materials.
