



## Safety & Health Circular No. 20/2009 Safety Reminder: Work Safety for Property Management at Construction Sites Immediately Before and After Public Holidays

The days immediately before and after Public Holidays are usually the busiest time for most trades. According to an analysis of occupational accidents involving serious consequences, these days are also highly accident-prone in most trades. In view of this, contractors, sub-contractors and service providers should all stay alert, put in place appropriate safety measures and monitor the effectiveness of such measures with a view to ensuring work safety during the above periods.
