Many materials used in workplaces, including chemicals, are flammable. Since the storage and use of these materials poses a certain degree of risk, appropriate and adequate safety measures should be taken.

For the sake of enhancing the industry's awareness of flammable materials and to facilitate the drawing up of related safety management measures, Labour Department has issued a leaflet with information on:

- Basic principles of combustion
- Types and risks of flammable materials
- Basic safety measures
- Emergency preparedness
