



Safety & Health Circular No. 05/2010 Guidance Notes on Safe Use of Loadshifting Machines for Earth Moving Operations on Construction Sites

In recent years there have been a number of serious accidents arising from the use of loadshifting machines for earth moving operations on construction sites. These accidents often arise due to one or a combination of factors including:

- the absence of a safe working system for the operation;
- inappropriate selection of equipment;
- operators not being properly trained;
- poor maintenance of equipment; and
- failure to observe necessary safety precautions.

The Labour Department has issued *Guidance Notes on Safe Use of Loadshifting Machines for Earth Moving Operations on Construction Sites.* The Guidance Notes include advice on the following:

- Establishing a safe system of work
- Selection of appropriate machines
- On-site inspection and maintenance
- Running safe operations
- Selection of responsible people
- Ensuring competence of mechanics
- Ensuring competence of operators
- Safety notes
