



Safety & Health Circular No. 08/2010 Guidance Notes on Safety on Working Platforms

Working at height is often required in the processes of different trades. Common work activities include construction work, internal and external renovation and maintenance work, as well as cleansing work.

As a high-risk work activity, working at height without proper safety precautions may lead to very serious accidents involving persons falling from height. The following article, published by Green Cross in September/October 2009 (ref: COPYRIGHT/383/2010-1856), provides guidance on safety on working platforms including:

- Safe Use of Working Platforms
- Mobile Elevated Working Platforms
- Mobile Metal Working Platforms
