



活動簡介

爲喚起業界對建造工程及物業管理安全的關注,由香港房屋委 員會及職業安全健康局首次合辦的「工程和物業管理安全約章暨安全 研討會」於2007年7月27日在國際展貿中心舉行。是次活動獲得房 屋署工地安全小組委員會所有外界常任成員支持,以支援機構的名義 參與。來自建造業、物業管理、維修保養和清潔行業的業界代表共八 百多人。

房屋署副署長(發展及建築)馮官萱與職業安全健康局主席伍 達倫聯同業界代表簽署「攜手共建安全文化」約章,約章述明:「管 業保養新工程,安全文化攜手建」,一起爲鞏固安全文化作出承諾。 房委會亦要求承辦商簽署安全約章,承諾訂定最高的工地安全標準及 確保工作場所健康安全,大家齊心合力,攜手共同建立安全文化。

簽署安全約章,顯示業界協力提高安全意識和推動安全文化的 重要性。此外,是項活動亦提供了一個難得機會,讓業內不同界別專 才就最佳作業模式跟與會者分享心得。工地安全研討會將成爲一年一 度的定期活動,房委會期望日後能繼續與業界攜手合作,一同推動建 造業安全文化。

The first "Works Contracts and Property Services Contracts Safety Charter Signing and Forum" jointly organized by Hong Kong Housing Authority and Occupational Safety & Health Council, and supported by all external standing members of the Housing Department Site Safety Committee, was convened on 27th July 2007 at HK International Trade and Exhibition Centre, to arouse the industry's concern towards safety at work for construction and property services. There were more than 800 participants coming from the fields of construction, property management, maintenance and cleansing.

Ms Ada Fung, Deputy Director of Housing (Development & Construction) and Dr Ng Tat-lun, Chairman of Occupational Safety & Health Council signed a "partnering for a safety culture" charter together with the representatives of the industry, pledging to work in partnership to foster a safety culture. In partnering for a safety culture, the Housing Authority also requires its contractors and service providers to set the highest site safety standard and ensure a healthy and safe workplace.

The signing of safety charter has marked the importance of the concerted efforts of all stakeholders for raising safety awareness and the promotion of a safety culture. This event has also provided a unique occasion for the exchange of best practice models by speakers from various sectors of the industry. The site safety forum will be regularized on an annual basis and the Housing Authority shall look forward to continual partnership with the industry to foster a safety culture.
