Partnering for a Safety Culture - Site Safety Forum 2008 for Works Contracts and Property Services Contracts, jointly organised by the Hong Kong Housing Authority (HA) and the Occupational Safety and Health Council (OSHC), aims at providing a platform for experience sharing among the works and property management industries through interactive discussions and sharing of successful experience to raise the awareness of occupational safety and health in the industries.
