

The Hong Kong Housing Authority and Occupational Safety & Health Council jointly organised the second "Works Contracts and Property Services Contracts Safety Forum" today (10 July 2008) to arouse the industry's concern towards safety at the work place. It is their second attempt following their first collaboration in 2007 which invited all industry partners to sign a Safety Charter pledging to working in partnership to foster a safety culture. Over a thousand participants coming from the fields of construction, property management, maintenance and cleansing attended the forum held at the HK International Trade and Exhibition Centre.

In the forum, CEOs of the construction, maintenance and property management companies were invited to attend three respective platforms to share their successful business models through interactive discussion which was well received by the participants.

Opening the forum, Mr Thomas Chan, Director of Housing, reiterated that partnership is the key success factor to the building of a safety culture. He thanked Mr Lee Kai Ming, Chairman of Occupational Safety & Health Council, as well as all the other supporting organisations for their concerted efforts in promoting safety culture in the work place. Whilst the forum has provided a unique occasion for sharing of valuable experience and best practice, tapping the "Safety Climate Index Survey" and "Hong Kong Safe & Healthy Estate Accreditation Scheme" initiatives have brought new dimensions in the perspective of partnering for a site safety culture.
