

香港房屋委員會與職業安全健康局合辦的「工程和物業管理工地安全研討會 2014」，於七月十六日舉行，推廣工地安全信息。

今年的研討會以「風險評估做得好，工地安全可提高」為主題，鼓勵業界重視風險管理，制定精確的安全措施，消除工地常見的風險。大會邀請了建造業、物業管理及潔淨服務業等的專業人士參與座談會，一起討論安全施工的實踐以及分享經驗，為六百多名從業員提供實用的工地安全資訊。

大會期望透過每年一度的「工程和物業管理工地安全研討會」，向業界推廣最新及最實用的安全資訊，同時提醒業界安全施工的重要性，強化從業員的安全意識，締造零事故的工作環境。

The Site Safety Forum for Works Contracts and Property Services Contracts 2014, jointly organised by the Hong Kong Housing Authority and the Occupational Safety and Health Council, was held on July 16 to promote site safety awareness.

The theme for this year's forum was "Risk Assessment is the Key to Site Safety". The industry was encouraged to enhance risk management and formulate precise safety measures so as to eliminate common risks at works sites. Professionals from the construction, property management and cleaning services sectors were invited to share their experience of different safety measures, offering practical information on site safety to over 600 participants.

Through the annual Site Safety Forum for Works Contracts and Property Services Contracts, the organisers aim to update the industry with the latest and practical safety information, and reinforce safe working and safety consciousness in order to create a safe workplace with "zero incidents".
