## **Enhancement for Site Safety**

- Expand the scope of restriction of subletting for works / trades involving significant hazards to include the trades of
  - external wall painting
  - plumbing / drainage

(limited to 2 tiers)

(PRE.B6.290.A)

 Revise contractual requirement on Silver Card in line with enhanced training by Construction Industry Council Training Academy (CICTA)
 (PRE.B6.150.A, PRE.C6.150.A & PRE.BS1.450.A)

- painter and decorator
- carpenter
- demolition worker (building)
- plumber
- bar bender and fixer
- plasterer and tiler
- bamboo scaffolder, metal scaffolder
- construction materials rigger
- curtain wall installer
- tower crane worker (erecting, dismantling, telescoping & climbing)
- lift mechanic and worker for lift installation (installation and maintenance)

Strengthen provision of full time Safety
 Officer (PRE.B6.150.A & PRE.C6.150.A)

 Reinforce specification for tower crane / lifting operations and related personnel (PRE.B8.242.N)

- competent examiner
- tower crane operator
- slinger (construction material rigger)
- signaller

Mandate slinger to work in pair with another site personnel within the lifting zone

Enhance Accident Reporting Mechanism

(PRE.B6.150.A & PRE.C6.150.A)

- Procedures for reporting and investigation non-serious, serious, fatal accidents and incidents (dangerous occurrence, near miss and death of persons not related to industrial accident) uploaded to HD's Counterparty Management Information System (COMIS)
- For non-listed contractor undertaking HA works contracts, CM in charge is to advise the contractor the required procedures upon contract commencement.
