We are happy to have Mr. Tsui and Mr. Cheung from Occupational Safety and Health Council to show us the analysis of past results, including findings of the audits and inspections in the fourth quarter of 2013 and in the first quarter of 2014.

I believe you must remember a serious industrial accident happened in Mid-levels two weeks ago. The accident took away two workers' lives. We are aware that such accidents are related to working at height. Last year, two thirds of deaths in accidents were direct results of fall of person from height.

Today we have invited Mr. Tam from Labour Department to go over regulations of works at height and relevant precautions. Recently, I have noticed that many contractors, in order to enhance efficiency of construction management, have used smart phone or mobile communication device to issue information to a colleague. Today we are also happy to have invited an information technology company to introduce how to enhance site safety management with mobile applications. Thank you Mr. Chan.

Facing the challenges in construction industry, we hope each fellow can work together to boost site safety in the industry. Friends who have come are encouraged to share the knowledge with your colleagues at work and support safety operations. Lastly, I wish you all the success and safety at work and happiness in life.
