 1. To report incident and disease cases happened on construction sites
 2. To assist contractors in completion of administrative forms for notification of accidents, incidents, and occupational diseases to HA
 3. To provide users alert when an action level / control limit is exceeded
 4. To provide HA users the capability to generate statistics for injury and disease surveillance

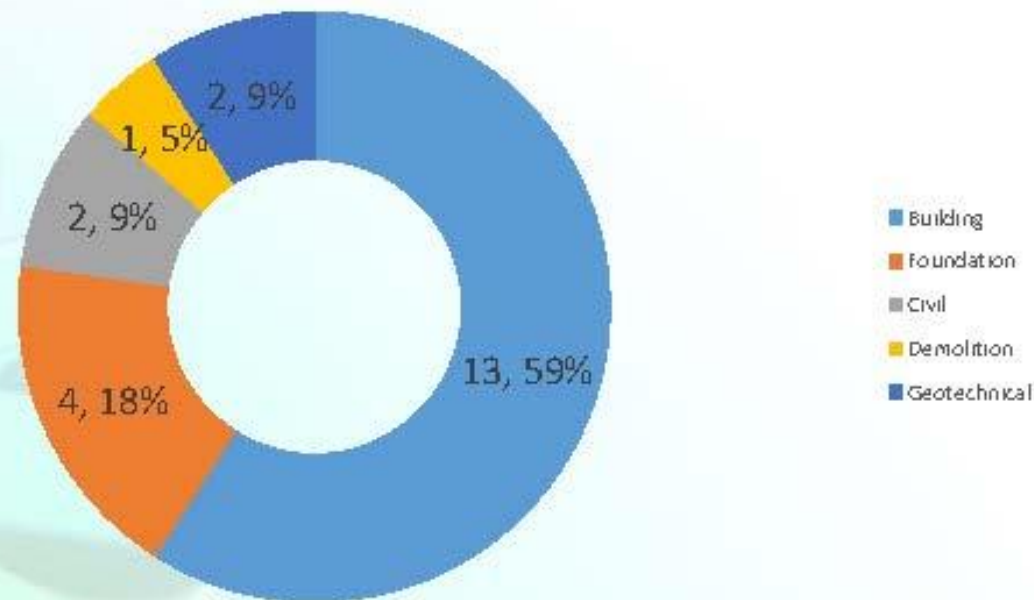
- The system was soft-launched on 1 April 2016.

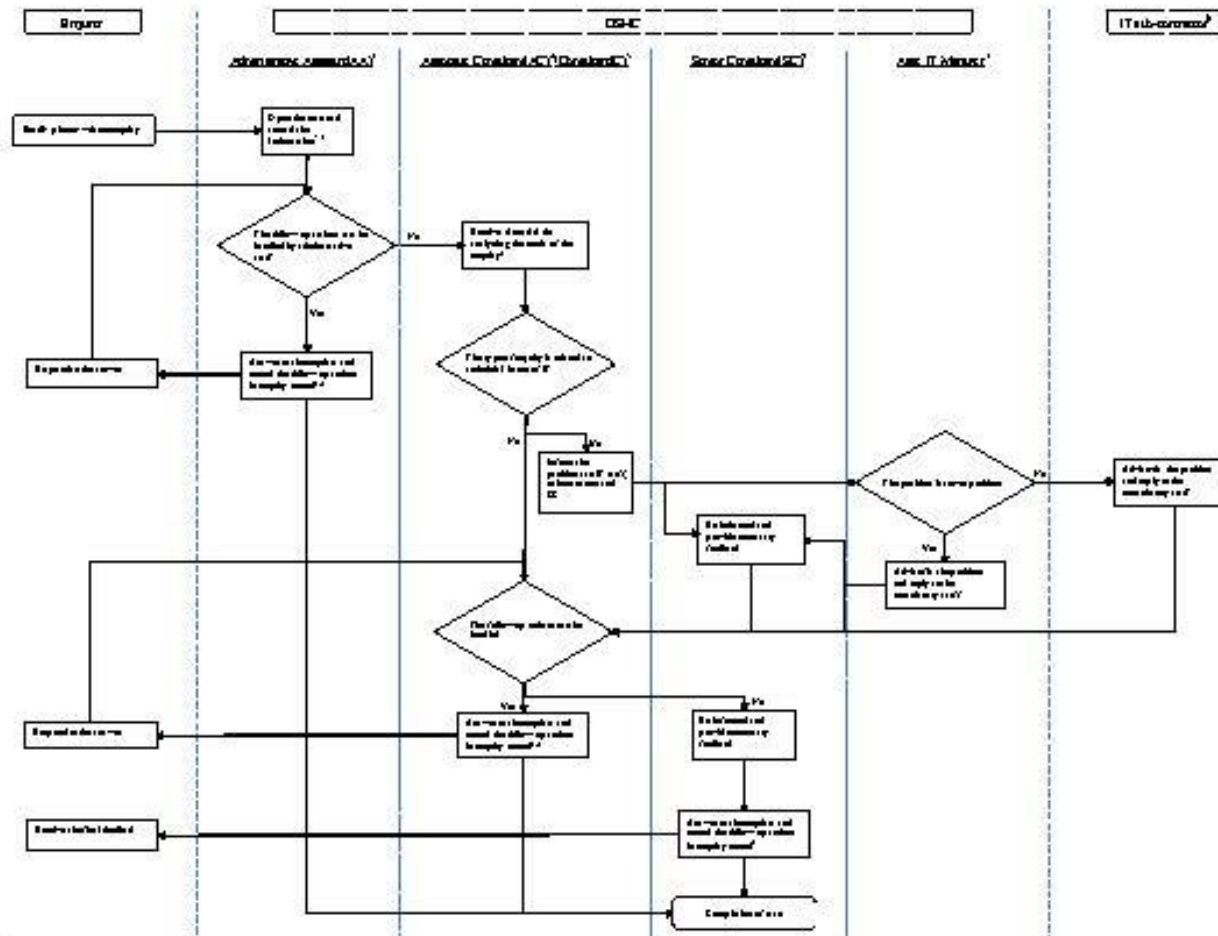
