Here is the footage from Safety Seminar for Capital Works New Works Contracts which was held on 11 December 2020 The speaker is Mr. Stephen LEUNG Assistant Director (Development and Procurement) Housing Authority He is now delivering a welcoming address Good afternoon guests friends and colleagues Welcome to the online version of Site Safety Seminar for Works Contracts today I would like to extend my thanks to the speakers today who continue to support us even though we are in the fourth wave of the COVID epidemic and for sharing the latest information on site safety Some of us may have played Virtual Reality (VR) games before And indeed nowadays the use of applied VR technology for site safety training is quite mature Both the size of VR equipment and the need for space to operate VR system have greatly been reduced To enhance site safety among the construction industry the Hong Kong Construction Association (HKCA) has designed 3 VR safety training scenarios In a short while Ms Mary Li Assistant Technical Secretary of HKCA and Mr Terry Dao Chief Executive Officer of VTM Digital Limited will introduce them to us in detail Through the Safety Auditing System and the Pay For Safety Scheme the Housing Authority (HA) encourages contractors to implement innovative safety measures on their construction sites Today we are grateful to have two contractors working for HA Mr Arnold Hui Safety Officer Yau Lee Construction Company Limited and Mr Jethro Chan Site Agent Able Engineering Company Limited to share with us their experiences of designing and applying innovative safety measures Site safety has always been a top priority for HA Every quarter we partner with the Occupational Safety and Health Council (OSHC) to conduct safety audits and surprise safety inspections for HA new works Apart from looking for areas for improvement more importantly we try to communicate and

exchange views directly with frontline workers to enhance the awareness of site safety Then Mr Jack Fong and Mr Henry Cheung Senior Consultants of OSHC will share with us their analysis of the results of the safety audits and surprise safety inspections conducted in Q2 and Q3 of 2020 We not only pay attention to the safety and health of our workers but also work hard to prevent incidents of underground utility damage during construction such as water main bursts power cable flashovers or gas leakage So today we have especially invited Ir Dr King Wong Recognized Professional Utility Specialist ex-Chair of Hong Kong Institute of Utility Specialists and Executive President of International Institute of Utility Specialists He will share key points of utility surveys and safety measures Lastly I wish everybody good health Please take care of your health and yourself on site You can browse the Housing Authority site safety website at any time and relay our messages about site safety today to your site colleagues Let us spread this safety information as widely as possible Thank you
