harbouring hidden hazards in work sites

A serious accident occurred this April, resulting in casualties

So the Labour Department has recently revised

the Code of Practice for Safety and Health at Work in Confined Spaces

gazetted in May and effective by the end of November

Today we also have Mr. LEUNG Hong Hang, Occupational Hygienist (Development) from the Labour Department

to share safety precautions for working in confined spaces

and the code of practice and its latest revisions

to gather attention on confined space safety

The Housing Authority consistently prioritizes site safety

cooperating with the Occupational Safety and Health Council

to conduct quarterly safety audits and surprise safety inspections at new works projects

Beyond identifying areas for improvement

the key goal is to enhance safety awareness among our teams and frontline personnel

and improve communication

Later Mr. Steve HU and Mr. Jack FONG, Senior Consultants from the Occupational Safety and Health Council

will analyse the results of surprise safety inspections and safety audits

in this year's Quarter 2 and 3

and share some good practices

hoping they can serve as references for everyone
