Hello, I have two questions to ask

When applying for the Smart Site Safety System Labelling Scheme

is it mandatory to have a centralised management platform

The second question is

if the project does not use smart site safety system products

listed under the Construction Innovation and Technology Fund

can it still apply for this scheme

Thank you for your questions, let me answer the first one first

As mentioned earlier, the centralised management platform in the Smart Site Safety System
Labelling Scheme

is not a mandatory requirement

Based on the recommended packages just mentioned

some trades are advised to have a centralised management platform while others are not

So even if you do not use a centralised management platform

you can still join the Scheme based on the smart site safety system products you have used

The second question is about the application of the Construction Innovation and Technology
Fund (CITF)

When submitting the form, we will ask what products you are using

If those products are the Construction Innovation and Technology Fund approved
they should have a product code, you can just fill in the code

If the products are not CITF approved

it does not mean you cannot apply

You can still apply for the Smart Site Safety System Labelling Scheme

However, you may need to provide additional information

to clarify the functionality and appearance of your product

so that during inspections, we know what we are checking for

As long as you submit all the required details, you can still apply for the Scheme
